TRIP DETAIL:

Between **7:30 and 8:00** in the morning, our driver and guide will meet you at the Chan May port gate, where your name will be displayed on a welcome board. After that, you'll transfer to see

- ❖ A popular beach in Thua Thien-Hue Province, **Lang Co Beach** is ranked among the world's ten most beautiful beaches and is a popular destination for tourists traveling from Danang to Hue.
- ❖ The highest crossing in Vietnam, **Hai Van Pass** is located between Thua Thien-Hue and Da Nang city and is considered to be one of the most picturesque mountain passes in the country.

At noon 12pm: Have lunch at a nearby restaurant and relax for a little while.





At 1:30pm, visit **Hoi An Ancient Town**, a well-preserved commercial harbor in Southeast Asia that was named a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Explore the well-known Japanese Covered Bridge, a covered bridge with a tile roof that was constructed by a community of Japanese traders in the early 17th century. Enter historic homes that date all the way back to the fifteenth century and that masterfully blend Vietnamese and Chinese architectural elements with Japanese elements. Discover several exquisitely crafted Historical Chinese Meeting Halls. Visit a nearby workshop to witness the artistic creation of handicrafts by skilled artisans.

Returning to Chan may port at **3 pm**.

Reach Chan May Port and conclude your tour there between **4:30 and 5:00 pm**.
